

Dear Mr. Lindsay:

The Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) has received the above document on February 2, 2000. Based on a review of the data presented in the document, there are no contaminants at the site above action levels for unrestricted use as listed in 18 AAC 75 Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Control Regulations (as amended through January 22, 1999). DEC will not require NOAA to conduct further investigation or remedial action at this time. The site will be considered closed out and no further action is necessary. However, please note that DEC reserves all of its rights under 18 AAC 75 and Alaska Statute 46 to require NOAA to conduct further investigation and/or remedial action if information indicates the site conditions are not protective of human health, safety, and welfare, and of the environment.
