

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) has received the above document on April 2, 2001. Based on a review of the data presented in the report, ADEC concurs with the Section 7.0 "Conclusions and Recommendations" that no further action is required at the Concrete Storage Bunker (a non-TPA site). ADEC reserves its rights, under 18 AAC 75 Oil and Other Hazardous Substances Pollution Control regulations and AS 46.03 to require NOAA to conduct additional assessment and/or corrective actions, if information indicates the site conditions pose an unacceptable risk to human health, safety, or welfare, or to the environment.
